Centre Shortlists Sites for Manmohan Singh's Memorial: The Central government has shortlisted two sites near Delhiâ??s Rajghat for setting up a memorial dedicated to former Prime Minister Manmohan Singh.

Arvind Kejriwal launches Pujari Granthi Samman Yojana: AAP supremo Arvind Kejriwal, along with his wife Sunita Kejriwal, on Tuesday launched the Pujari Granthi Samman Yojana by registering the priests of Marghat Wale Baba temple near Kashmiri Gate ISBT for the benefits. Under the scheme, the Hindu temple priests and granthis of Gurudwaras will be paid a monthly honorarium of Rs 18,000 if the AAP returns to power.

Blinkit Launches 10-Minute Ambulance Service in Gurgaon: Blinkit CEO Albinder Dhindsa announced the launch of an instant ambulance service in Gurgaon, allowing residents to book an ambulance via the Blinkit app with a delivery time of just 10 minutes.
