## **National News:**

The RBI has approved the merger of Bangalore-based **National Co-operative Bank** with **Cosmos Co-operative Bank of Maharashtra**, effective January 6, 2025, as part of ongoing banking sector consolidation. Post-merger, National Co-operative Bank branches will function under Cosmos Co-operative.

**SBI** has launched two new deposit schemes: **Har Ghar Lakhpati**, a recurring deposit plan helping customers save â?<sup>11</sup> lakh or more, and SBI Patrons, a fixed deposit scheme offering higher interest rates for senior citizens aged 80 and above.

India is revising its GDP base year from 2011-12 to 2022-23 to better reflect the current economic landscape. This update, aimed at improving the accuracy of national accounts, will be implemented by early 2026.

Tamil Nadu Chief Minister **MK Stalin** inaugurated Indiaâ??s first glass bridge in **Kannyakumari**, connecting the **Vivekananda Rock Memorial** and **Thiruvalluvar Statue**. Built under a Rs 37-crore project by the Tamil Nadu government, the bridge aims to enhance tourism in the region.

The Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) has recently amended the Foreign Trade Policy (FTP) 2023. This amendment introduces new provisions aimed at enhancing stakeholder engagement in the formulation and amendment of trade policies.

The Employeesâ?? Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) has successfully rolled out its Centralised Pension Payments System (CPPS) across India. This initiative benefits over 68 lakh pensioners and modernises the pension disbursement process.

The **Gujarat** government is preparing to launch Indiaâ??s inaugural census of **coastal and wader birds**. This landmark event will occur at the Marine National Park and Sanctuary in Jamnagar from January 3 to 5, 2025.

In December 2023, **Odisha** experienced unprecedented unseasonal rainfall, leading to crop damage. Chief Minister **Mohan Charan Majhi** announced this weather event as a natural calamity during the **â??Krushi Odisha Conclaveâ??** in Bhubaneswar. This declaration aims to expedite compensation for farmers affected by the rainfall, allowing access to the state disaster response fund (SDRF).
