National News:

Lieutenant Governor (L-G) V.K. Saxena has approved the appointment of IAS officer Azimul Haque as the CEO of the **Delhi Waqf Board**. However, he criticized the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) government for its alleged negligence and failure to follow legal procedures in handling the situation.

India has achieved a major milestone by expanding its metro rail network to over **1,000 km**, making it the **world's third-largest** after China and the US. Starting with the Kolkata Metro in 1984, the network now spans 23 cities in 11 states.

The **Odisha** government has signed a three-year sponsorship deal worth **â?¹15 crore** for the Indian national **kho kho team**, aiming to promote the indigenous sport. Funded by the Odisha Mining Corporation, this initiative will support team development, infrastructure, and global participation.

The **University Grants Commission (UGC)** has introduced new regulations for the appointment and promotion of teachers in higher education. Released on January 6, 2025, by Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan, these draft regulations clarify the selection process for Vice-Chancellors.
